FROM GENESIS TO REVELATION: CONFESSING CHRIST AT THE END OF THE AGE

We are living in times unprecedented, in which a woman can say, "I am a man trapped in a woman's body." How did we get here? And what will be the church's response? During these sessions we will talk about the relationship between Genesis and Revelation, the creation and redemption, the Law and the Gospel. We will explore the relationship between abortion, the sexual revolution, same sex marriage, and gender dysphoria. We will come to see how the rainbow pride and Critical Race Theory are siblings, ideologies that aim at the very abolition of man. So called social issues are deeply theological issues, and the question of our humanity shapes the way we think of Christ. There is no escape from this secular onslaught, so we must be prepared to engage in the church militant, and to make a strong confession for the sake of our church and our children.

Joining the Concordia Theological Seminary (CTSFW), Fort Wayne, Exegetical Department in 2000, he serves as professor and chairman of the Exegetical department. His passions include the Gospel of Mark, highlighting the sacramental ministry of Jesus. He loves to show how the life and teachings of Christ anticipates and forms the life of the Church. He is deeply involved in life issues and serves as president of Allen County Right to Life. He is a founding member of Shepherds United, an ecumenical Christian group formed to defend life, natural marriage and religious liberty. He speaks out on the issues that affect both our Church and society, always placing the focus on Christ, who gives us life and defines for us what it means to be truly human. He and his wife, Amy, are blessed with three children.
