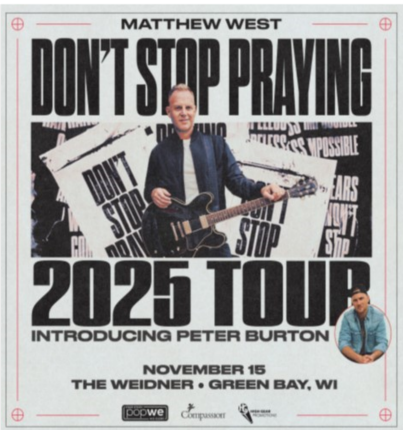
I.T. HELP NEEDED:
