"HONOR YOUR LEADERS ... "

"Honor your leaders" ... "obey your leaders and submit to them."

HEBREWS 13:7a, 17a

The month of August honors Caesar Augustus, who ruled the Roman Empire in the time when Jesus was born. Caesar Augustus laid out a registration law for taxation, which brought Joseph (and Mary, "great with Child") to his ancestral home in Bethlehem, where Jesus was born.

Although most of the Jewish religious leaders resented Roman rule, and tried to entrap Jesus to speak against Rome, he showed respect for those whom God had placed into secular office.

Regardless of our view toward any elected official, we are to both honor and obey (unless obedience would sin against God) those leaders who serve us in the place of God ruling directly. We honor offices, and pray for God to raise up good and fair and wise leaders who fill leadership offices and serve Him and the common good.

Technically, these verses refer to those who lead with the goal of our spiritual growth, serving under Christ, our ultimate leader. The elected officers of St. John serve Christ and the rest of our church family. We honor, serve, and obey them as unto God.

Above all, we are reminded that, regardless of title, God is the one who is truly "auguste," worthy of unquestioned honor and respect and obedience, no matter what. Thanks be to God for His auguste character and involvement in our lives. ~ Pastor Gimbel
