



Bible Studies and Small-Group Meetings begin August 1 with Safety Expectations

St. John's Lutheran Ministries is moving forward with the reopening. We will be doing this carefully and strategically. Usage of the Christian Life Center for small group activities will return on August 1 with the following expectations:

- No more than 36 people may be present in the Christian Life Center
- Masks will be required for groups of over 18 people.
- No food or beverage will be served to the group at this time. Individuals may bring their own drinks in a personal container.
- Use all the tables to promote social distancing.
- Limit the number of people at a table to 2 individuals with no one directly facing another person. (If a household is larger than two people, there would be an exception to the 2 person per table rule.)
- Each group must disinfect all surfaces and bathrooms before and after each event. Two spray bottles of disinfectant will be available in the Christian Life Center.
- We are exploring the usage of Zoom for people to participate from home if they do not feel comfortable with large groups.

All groups that wish to begin meeting should [contact Catharine](#) in the church office (Monday through Thursday, 8:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.) to be put back on the official church calendar. (Some groups may wish not to meet yet and we do not want to assume anything.)

There will not be any Bible study on Sundays at 9:15 until the service schedule returns to regular times.
