Jesus experienced this, and the writer to the Hebrews also expressed, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus, the author and perfector of our faith, who for the joy set before him endured the cross, scorning it shame and sat down at the right hand of the throne of God. (Hebrews 12:2). Jesus knew what was about to happen as he approached His suffering and death, but he could approach it with joy because he also knew of the great joy that would come because of his resurrection from the dead and his ascension into heaven.

In the same way we can approach the things that happen in our life with joy. We can have that joy that only comes through faith in Christ Jesus. We can stand with confidence with St. Paul as he says," For I am convinced that neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons, neither the present nor the future, nor any powers, neither height nor depth, nor anything else in all creation, will be able to separate us from the love of God that is in Christ Jesus our Lord. (Romans 8:38-39).

That joy is ours eternally! Live in that joy and share it with others.






