





## From the Principal's Pen...

showed their spirit and enthusiasm. The passion demonstrated itself by screaming wildly, face painting, and even body paint to point out their loyalty to the team. If one were new to our society, it would be thought that life and death importance was placed on the game. Soon, however, the passion and the joy dissipate as we meander on to the next thing in life. What once seemed important, quickly fades and is all but forgotten in the following week.





The writer to the Hebrews expresses the passion when he says, "Therefore, since we are surrounded by such a great cloud of witnesses, let us throw off everything that hinders and the sin that so easily enables, and let us run with perseverance the race marked out for us" (Heb. 12: 1). Notice that before one has true passion and joy, one must throw off all other things that might slow down or entangle so that full concentration can be placed on the ultimate goal. This is not an easy thing to do, but through the power of the Holy Spirit we are enabled to do it.

The power than to have the passion and joy will flow. The writer continues, "Let us fix our eyes on Jesus the author and perfector of our faith" (Heb. 12:2). 


