Many times, we also treat our God with the same impatience. We use prayer as a tool to make demands and expect immediate results. We see our Lord as a great ATM machine in which we just must input the right words or attitude into the formula and then expect a fountain of blessings to pour our way. There are many current Christian writers out there who talk of prosperity living and chastise those who are struggling to just pray correctly and get their life focused.

God, however, does not promise this. He promises to hear all our prayers and His answers are determined by His love for us. St. Paul wrestled with this when he was struggling with a personal malady. God responded to him, ""My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." 
