

From the Principal's Pen...

The other week, I was talking with some upper grade students and one of them said, "I just love the weekend!" Not that there is something wrong about this statement, but it made me think about the use of the word "love" in this statement. Knowing that I was about to write the lead-off article for the month of February, it made me stop and think about this tiny little word and how it is abused so much in our vocabulary today.

In the original language of the Greek used by the people of the New Testament era there are four words that can be translated into love in the English language.

- 1. Philio-Brotherly love;
- 2. Storge-familial love:
- 3. Eros-romantic love;
- 4. Agape is unconditional love.



Of these only philio and agape appear in the New Testament. The most important is agape because this is the type of love God shows to us. It is poured out to us without any hesitation from our God who was and is willing to sacrifice all for us.

This month we continue our yearly theme Connected to Christ with the phrase *Connected to Christ through His love*. It is based on 1Johns 4:7-8, "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because "God is love." Notice it doesn't say God shows love, but God is love. Love is the absolute essence of what God is and His love for us flows from that. St. Paul describes the power and purpose of God's love when he writes, "but God shows his love us in that while were still sinners, Christ died for us" (Romans 5:8). His love for us is unconditional. His love lives in us.

But love doesn't stop there. Notice the verse says, let us love one another. How many problems in our society and in our school could be solved by showing the love that lives in us through Christ our Savior. It will never be perfect this side of heaven because of our sinful condition, but God

through the work of the Holy Spirit, can give us the power to demonstrate God's love.



During this month as we go through Valentines Day and the start of the Lent season, let us never forget that our God has showered His love on us. We should strive to show love to one another. Living in this love, we should praise Him for it.
