Each and every message on a car helps define the perception of the person who is driving. That perception may be correct, or it may be wrong, but people get all types of ideas about the person in the vehicle by the messages displayed on the bumper.




If Jesus had lived in our day, people would have placed all types of bumper stickers on His vehicle. One might have read messages like, "Listen to the guy" or "Elijah has come back," or "Prophet on board." People of Jesus' day had all types of ideas as to who He was. Even His disciples did not really understand who He was.

There is no doubt of this uncertainty as Jesus took His disciples to the top of the mountain. There, before their eyes, our Lord was transfigured. In that one moment of time, the disciples were stunned by the glory of God. It is no wonder that Peter responded with the awkward statement, "Lord, it is good that we are here. If you wish, I will make three tents here." (Matt. 17:4a) No doubt they were wondering what exactly they were seeing and experiencing.

But God left no room for doubt. While Peter was still speaking, God interrupted and said, "This is my beloved Son, with whom I am well pleased; listen to Him" (Matt. 17:5). From that moment on, Peter, James, and John had no doubt as to whom Jesus was. Peter himself stated, "We were eyewitnesses of His majesty. We ourselves heard this very voice, borne from heaven, for we were with him on that holy mountain." (2 Peter 1:16d & 18). This event would stand as a buttress to their belief for all time that the Lord God of heaven was the One who came to this Earth, died for their sins, and was raised from the dead.

We, today, are also buttressed by this event. We have the blessing of His Word inerrantly written so that we might believe. The facts are in place. We need to study His Word so that we might learn of our salvation. As it states in Acts, "And there is salvation in no one else, for there is no other




As we prepare for the February 24th School Dance the Parent Teacher League has a list of ways to help make this event spectacular.


