

### From the Principal's Pen...

Spring is almost here! Although it still possible to get some snow in April, one knows that it is only a matter of time before the grass will begin to turn green and the leaves will once again fill the trees.



Much of my time as principal has been in communities that have had a significant tie to the agriculture. If not yet, the farmers will begin to work the fields in preparation for the planting of their crops. Once the soil is prepared, the planters will be filled with tiny little kernels that don't seem to have any life in them. With great precision the planter will move through fields injecting these seemingly lifeless objects in the ground. Several weeks will pass by before the tiny green shoots will

sprout from the ground. As the weeks and months go by this tiny seed will develop into a very tall corn stalk.

The human spiritual life can be like this seed. When one faces death and stands the graveside of a loved one it can appear that there is nothing but decay and hopelessness, but for Christians that is not the case. Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. Whoever believes in me, though he die, yet shall he live" (John 11:25). As Christians we can stand with sure and certain hope that we will rise as Christ rose from the dead. We will rise to eternal life with our Lord and Savior. This is the absolute and most important connection to Christ that we have. This is the reason that St. John's Lutheran Ministry exists. 
