### FROM THE PRINCIPAL'S PEN...

Several years ago I was watching a cable television show named <u>Behind Closed Doors</u>. During the course of the program, the host followed behind the Publishers Clearing House sweepstakes personnel. She met with them as they plotted their strategy and formulated their plans to bring off the big surprise of the \$10 million grand prize. When the prize was finally awarded to a Catholic priest in a small town in Iowa, the shock expressed on the face of the winner demonstrated the pure joy. All the planning, preparation, and execution of the plan went flawlessly.



The surprise and joy shown by this one man is nothing compared to the joy and amazement demonstrated by a group of individuals over two thousand years ago. They had stood on the rugged rock outside of the city of Jerusalem and watched with horror as their master, friend, and teacher had been brutally executed. The darkness that shrouded this afternoon must have amplified the deep sorrow felt and expressed by the many disciples. The earthquake that shook the area when He died brought terror into their lives. For them, the world had ended that

mid-afternoon. They had buried their Lord and their God.

They failed to see the plan. God had perfectly described the events that would take place throughout the Old Testament. The Bible says, "But when the fullness of time had come, God sent His Son, born of a woman, born under law, to redeem those who were under law, so that we might receive adoption as sons" (Gal. 4:4-5). The God who had promised a Savior to Adam and Eve in the garden, fulfilled that promise on the cross.

The gloom that permeated that day was soon to dissipate. Early that Sunday morning, Jesus fulfilled another promise. The angel came and opened the tomb. The guards fell in fright. 




