 - + 6th Petition: lead us not into temptation
 - + 7th Petition: but deliver us from evil
- * Use a word bank to fill out the Third Petition, put the phrases in order on the 4th Petition, and match to complete the 5th Petition. (16)
- * Write out Matthew 6:33 (3)
