

**WORKSHEET #2 -The Lord's Supper, What It Is and What It Is Not**

Read the Small Catechism, Section I - The Nature of the Sacrament questions 285-295. Circle the number of those statements below that are true about the Lord's Supper.

1. The Lord's Supper is one of our seven Sacraments.
2. In the Lord's Supper, I receive only bread and wine.
3. In the Lord's Supper, I don't receive the body of Christ because it is not possible.
4. The Lord's Supper is a place to show that my family gets along with each other.
5. Going to the Lord's Supper shows everybody that I am a Christian.
6. Going to the Lord's Supper is only a personal matter.
7. I could go to heaven even if I refused to go to the Lord's Supper.
8. As long as I can walk up to the Lord's Supper, I should go.
9. If I do something really bad, I should not go to the Lord's Supper because it will make God mad at me.
10. The Lord's Supper is something I go to in order to keep God happy.
11. The Lord's Supper gives me personal assurance that God does forgive me.
12. There is no real reason to prepare myself before going to the Lord's Supper.
13. Even if I have not committed a terrible sin, I should still go to the Lord's Supper regularly.
