

WORKSHEET #4 - Ready or Not? (Worthy and Unworthy)

Read Small Catechism Section IV questions 299-306. Respond "T" or "F" to the following statements.

- ___ 1. To be unworthy means that I have committed a terrible sin.
- ___ 2. To be worthy means that I've lived a pretty good life.
- ___ 3. If I receive the Lord's Supper when I am unworthy, I will take it to my harm.
- ___ 4. If I realize that I was not worthy in the past when I received the Lord's Supper, I should worry about it for many years.
- ___ 5. In order for me to be worthy, I must have faith in Jesus as my Savior.
- ___ 6. If I doubt that the Lord's Supper really forgives me, I am unworthy.
- ___ 7. Before going to the Lord's Supper, I should recognize that I am a sinner who needs Christ.
- ___ 8. When I receive the Lord's Supper in a worthy manner, I should remember to tell others about His work for me.
- ___ 9. I will go to the Lord's Supper regularly because it's the thing to do.
- ___ 10. I will go to the Lord's Supper regularly because I sin daily and need God's assurance of forgiveness.
- ___ 11. If I got drunk on Saturday night and don't see anything wrong with it, I should still go to the Sacrament.
- ___ 12. If I got drunk on Saturday night and were really sorry that it happened, I should go to the Lord's Supper.
- ___ 13. If I lied to my parents about where I was on Friday night and I don't care, I should still go to the Lord's Supper.
- ___ 14. If I went too far in a relationship, I should go to the Lord's Supper and ask God to forgive me so I can do the same thing again.
- ___ 15. As long as I say the right words, I am worthy to receive the Lord's Supper.
- ___ 16. The Lord's Supper is so important to me that I will prepare myself before I go.
