


Ladies Aid Summer Potluck



Programs are broadcast at 9:00 a.m. central time on FOX station KVRR Fargo-Moorhead Channel 15.1. Or you can watch archived episodes any time on their website at www.mainstreetliving.com (then click on "North (Fargo)."



Here's the programs for August:

August 6: Rev. Thomas Marcis, Zion Lutheran Church, Bismarck, ND, presents the message: "Don't Just Send Them Away" based on Matthew 14:13-21. *This Is the Life*: "No Laughing Matter" – A woman must learn to deal with her past in order to help someone else in her present.

August 13: Rev. Christopher Lieske, Trinity Lutheran Church, Fergus Falls, MN, presents the message: "The Lord Who Saves" based on Matthew 14:22-23. *This Is the Life*: "My Husband, My Sorrow" – A man and woman must deal with whether they should consummate an adulterous affair.

August 20: Rev. Daniel Larsen, St. Paul's Lutheran Church, Henning, MN, presents the message: "Jealous" based on Romans 11:1-2a, 13-15, 28-32. *This Is the Life*: "The Cup" – The dilemma a trucker must face when a good friend dies trying to protect him.

August 27: Rev. Timothy Schmeisser, Grace Lutheran Church, Sebeka, MN, Zion Lutheran Church, Sebeka, MN, and Nimrod Lutheran Church, Nimrod, MN, presents the message: "Back To Basics" based on Matthew 16:13-20. *This Is the Life*: "Stranger at the Door" – Having given up a baby for adoption 22 years before, a man shows up on a woman's steps saying he is looking for his mother.



If your cable doesn't have KVRR, you can watch a different version (different pastors, mainly from Minnesota South) on WFTC out of the Twin Cities, Sundays at 9:00 a.m.

We Could Do A New Pictorial Church Directory



Use simple ingredients and your imagination to bake these fluffy, cloud-like treats.

What you need:

- 3 egg whites
- ½ tsp. vanilla extract
- Mixer
- 2 Tbsp. powdered sugar
- 1 Tbsp. cornstarch
- · Parchment paper

What you do:

- 1. Preheat oven to 300°. In a mixing bowl, combine egg whites and vanilla. Whisk eggs with mixer at medium speed until frothy.
- While whisking, gradually add sugar and cornstarch. Keep whisking at high speed until stiff peaks form.
- Spoon mixture onto a baking sheet lined with parchment paper. Create fun shapes.
- 4. Bake 20 minutes. Cool and enjoy!






