Special Voters Meeting Sunday August 17, 2025, 9:15 a.m.

Subject: Acceptance of improvements recommended by the Refresh Action Committee.

<u>A/V Improvements</u> – Hire Digital Horizons to modernize our Sound and Graphic systems to improve the live streaming of our services, modify the speaker system in sanctuary, and visual upgrades with larger digital screens. Budget of \$45,000. [finance with existing Line of Credit at Citizens Bank.] Start work immediately.

<u>Communion Rail Relocation</u> – Relocate communion rail to the same level as the seating to eliminate steps to communion. The new location will allow for 50% more at each table. And the railing will be removable for weddings and other functions. This modification includes the deletion of one row of pews. Budget unknown at this printing. Start work January 1, 2026.

<u>Sanctuary Flooring</u> – New carpeting for altar area and communion rail, and new LVP flooring from new communion rail to rear of room in isles and under pews. Pews will be removed and replaced for installation of flooring. Budget of \$28,000. Start work January 1, 2026. Flooring cost for the rest of building dependent on the procedure to separate carpet from original floor tile. Budget \$100,000 until confirmed.

<u>Painting</u> – A. Sanctuary Budget \$7000. B. South entrance and west rooms Budget \$12,000. C. North entrance and east classrooms Budget \$14,000. Start work A & B January 1, 2026.
