The following numbers reflect STAR testing in reading for the 2016-2O17 students. They give a snapshot of the previous year of school. They display outcomes as compared to Michigan state standards, M-STEP proficiencies, and National Norms (students across the United States).

- STAR Reading plots student scores against a proficiency field and compares them accordingly...these are the ratings for St. John's students tested in comparison to the M-STEP (Michigan standardized test):
- In reading, 90\% scored PP or above
- In math, $91 \%$ scored PP or above

- Grade Equivalent (GE) is a norm-referenced score that represents how a student's test performance compares with other students nationally. For example, a fifth-grade student with a GE score of 7.6 performed as well as a typical seventh-grader after the sixth month of the school year.
- In reading, $84 \%$ of our students scored AT or ABOVE the expected grade level
- In math, $92 \%$ of our students scored AT or ABOVE the expected grade level
