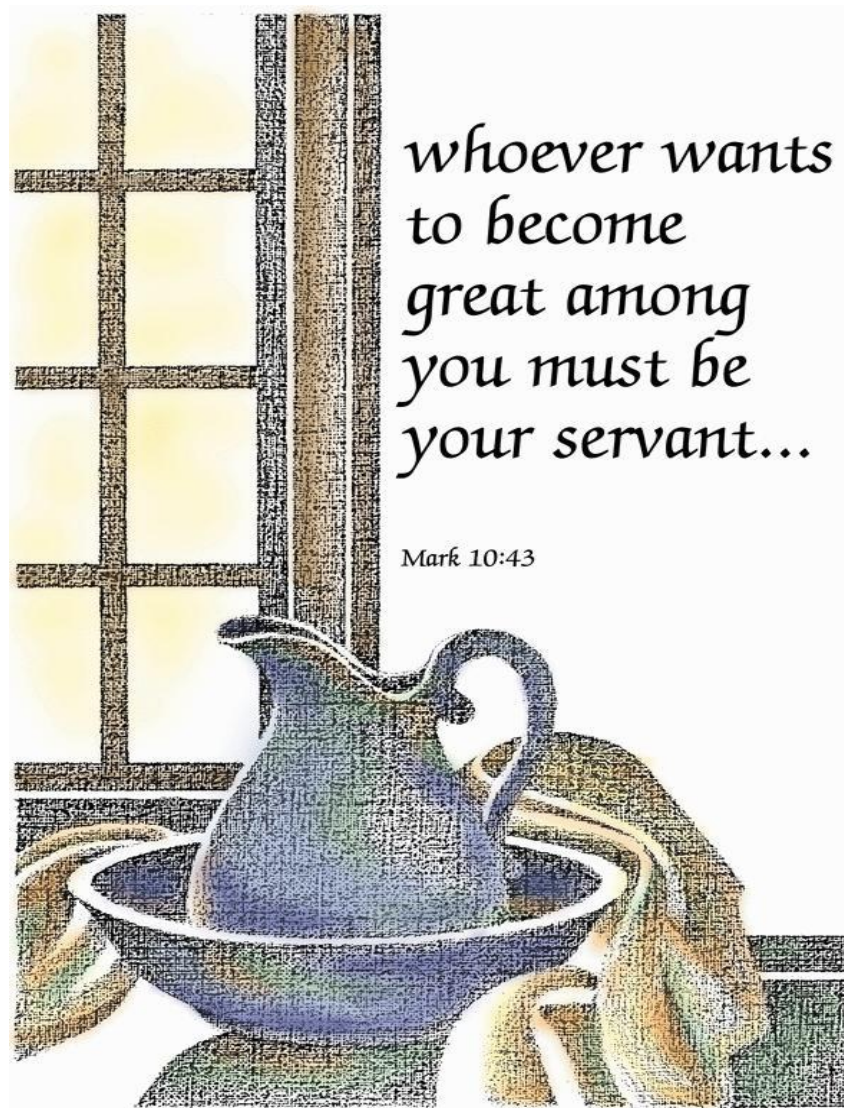

*"If I've learned anything about friendship, it's to hang in, stay connected," says journalist Jon Katz.
