17. Neat Repeats- misc. items

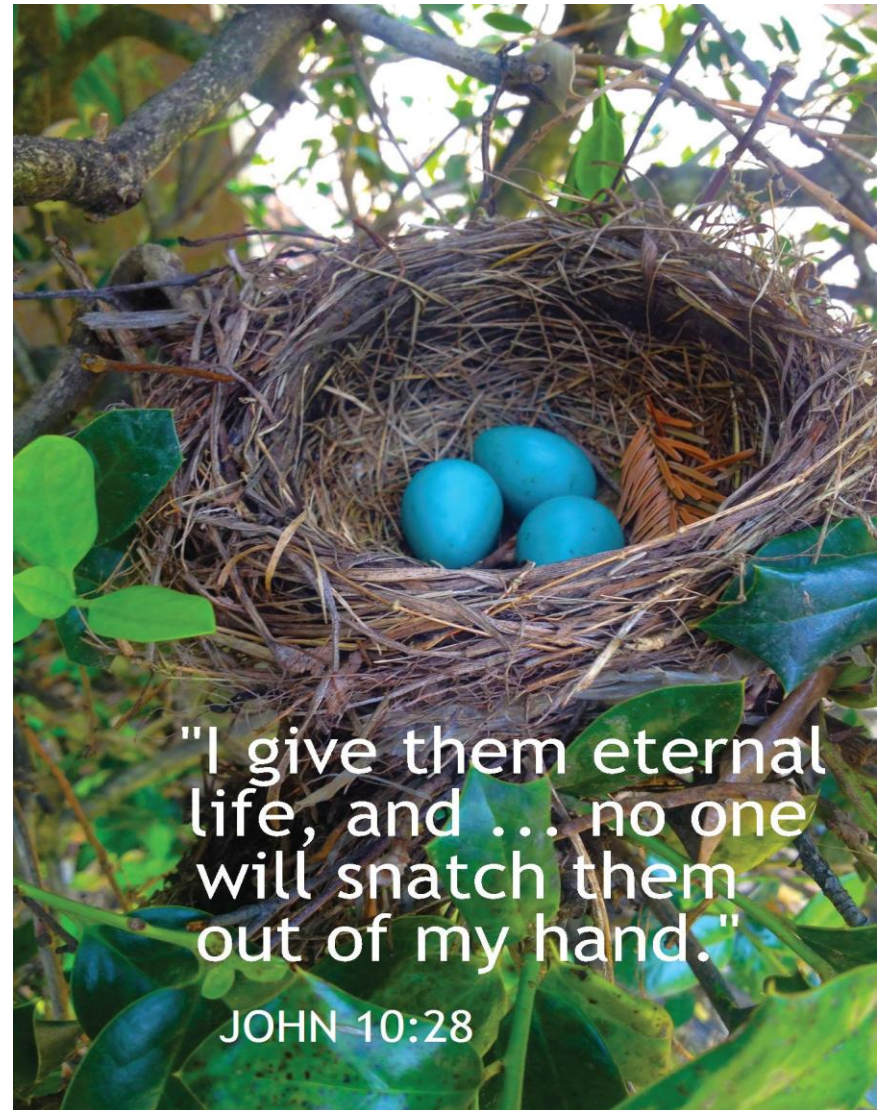
Special note: Over 45 families donated items, 15 families donated baked goods and over 35 people helped with the sale in some way. Over 450 hours of time to make this all happen.
