LENTEN GOAL: Last year we collected funds to purchase 134 pairs of shoes so children in Tanzania could attend school. Now that these children can attend, let's feed them a school lunch so they can learn and feed their minds. While there are some schools that are able to serve students a simple lunch of uji (thin corn meal porridge) or ugali (a thicker corn meal porridge), there are many schools that can not. **The availability of this noon meal ultimately depends on the financial means of the children's parents.** But with an average household income of less than \$1 a day, paying for a school lunch is often the expense that becomes little more than a hope and promise, especially when there are often 6 or more children in a family. **\$25 will pay for 50 students to have one school lunch (1 day).** St. Luke's goal is to feed the 50 students for 134 days (\$3350.00). Take a "take out meal" bank for a reminder and encouragement to contribute to this worthy cause. Donations will be accepted from Ash Wednesday (February 26) until April 19. Checks can be made out to St. Luke Lutheran Church with "meals" in the memo line. If you have questions, please contact Andrea in the office.
