These young women are not only learning the art of lace making, they are generating their own income as the lace is marketed as far away as Belgium and the US. The young women edge linen squares with this delicate lace and hand-embroider a dove in one corner, creating beautiful baptismal napkins. These napkins are lovingly used by St. Luke to support this LWR project.
