P: The God of all grace + bless you now and forever. **Amen.**

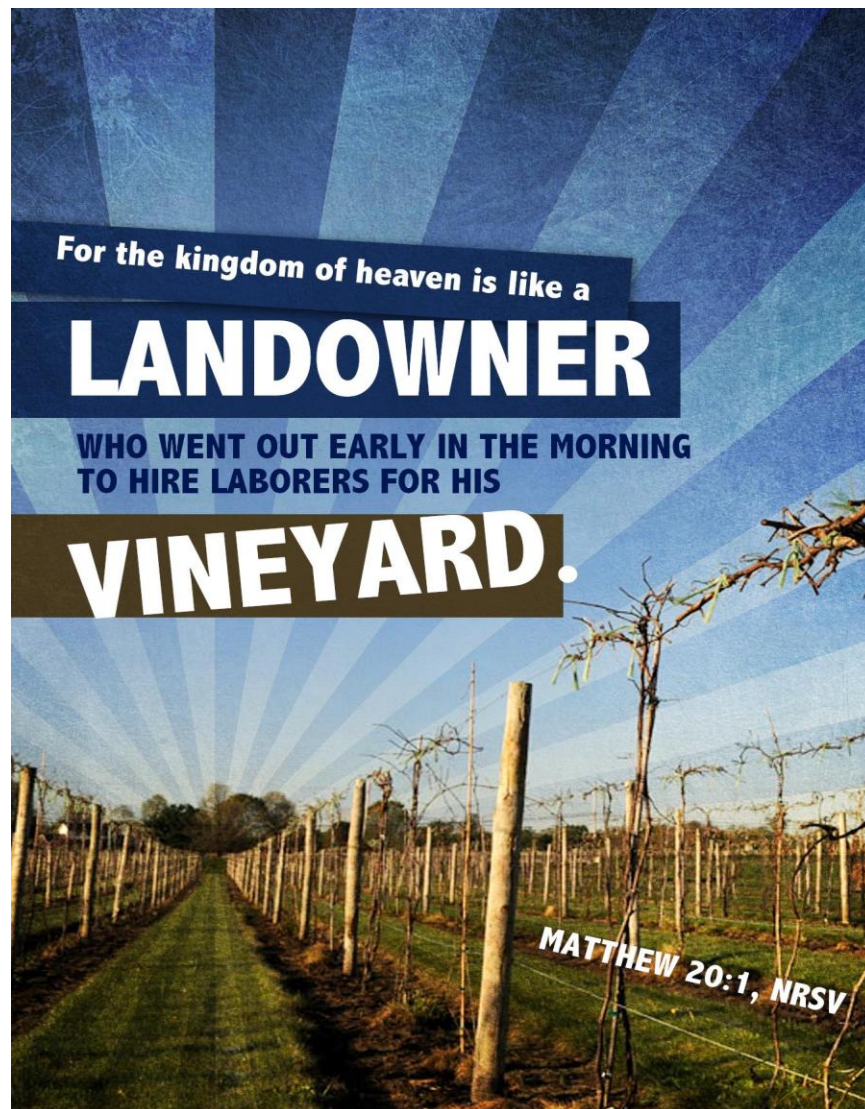
