SUNDAY SCHOOL- Becky Kuhlow (920-207-2515) is continuing to be our Sunday School





Confirmation Instruction is a partnership between the church and family meant to help young people learn the basic teachings of faith - the Ten Commandments, the Apostles' Creed, the Lord's Prayer and the Holy Sacraments, so that they can affirm their baptisms, and claim the eternal blessings that God bestowed upon them through the water and the Word.



During Confirmation we also provide fun fellowship events, worship, games and service opportunities. The weekly lessons follow Martin Luther's Small Catechism. Pastor Dave will lead the class on Sunday mornings from 8:30 to 9:15 AM. The program typically is two years. In addition to St. Luke's Seventh and Eighth Graders, if you know of a young person, perhaps a nephew, niece, a grandchild, a neighbor's and/or co-workers child, who does not need to be a member of St. Luke, who could benefit from Confirmation Instruction, please call the church office at (920) 467-6149. The Sunday School Superintendent, Becky Kuhlow and/or Pastor Dave will follow up with the parents. Call to Order: President Aaron Strassburger called the meeting to order at 10:30 a.m. A quorum (9 members) was declared. 32 members were present. No additional agenda items were added.

Devotions: Interim Pastor Dave Patterson led us in devotions and prayer based on the hymn, "O God Our Help in Ages Past".

Minutes of the Special Congregational Meeting:

A. Debbie Meyer moved and Carol Wedepohl seconded that the minutes of the Special Congregational Meeting, Sunday, April 23, 2023 be approved. (See attached minutes.) Adopted.

Reports:

A. Interim Pastor: See attached report.

B. Treasurer: Debbie Meyer reported on the General Fund, Capital Fund, Endowment Fund, and the Summary of actual costs vs. the budgeted costs of our church. See attached reports. Dave Lammers moved and Florence Popp seconded that the Treasurer's report be approved. Adopted

C. Committee Reports:

- 1. Call Committee: Becky Kuhlow reported that the executive committee of our church council and the call committee chairperson from our church have held several meetings to discuss having a shared Pastor with members of the church council of Gloria Dei Lutheran Church, New Holstein. Pastor Kristin Nielsen from the Greater Milwaukee Synod staff has asked for a meeting with both church councils and call committees to keep up with the conversations between the churches on the shared Pastor possibility. Becky also reported that there are no pastoral candidates for us to interview at this time.
- **2. Worship:** Kathy Nelson reported that a recap of the last six months of worship committee is found in the attached report.
- 3. Education: Becky Kuhlow reported that Vacation Bible School will be held August 7-10, 6:30 p.m. 8:30 p.m. at the church. The theme is Twists and Turns, a boardgame theme centered on following Jesus as a gamechanger. A family night will be held on August 10. There are 14 children pre-enrolled. There will be a back pack blessing on August 27 and rally day will be September 17. Sunday Church School classes and confirmation class will begin on September 10 at 8:30 a.m. Trunk or Treat is scheduled for Oct. 21 and will include a brat fry this year. Dec. 2 is the Main Street Memories Parade in Sheboygan Falls and Becky would like to have the Sunday School children march in the parade. The Christmas Sunday Church School program is tentatively scheduled for Sunday, Dec. 17.
- **4. Maintenance:** Aaron Strassburger reported that the air conditioning had a small issue this morning. He has also been working on lighting in the church. Aaron has one estimate for landscaping at the parsonage. He will obtain one or more bids before a decision is made on this project. Landscaping the parsonage will help with the water issue in the parsonage basement. Long term maintenance issues are the north parking lot and the church roof.
- **5. NOW:** Laura Meyer reported that the NOW (Nurture, Outreach, Witness) overview plan is posted on the bulletin board in the Narthex. Volunteers are needed for the following fall projects: Helping Kids September; God's Work, Our Hands September 10; Trunk or Treat brat fry October 21; and Love Lights December. See attached report.
- **6. Arts and Environment:** Lavonne Schroeder thanked Paul Schroeder, Nancy Hass, and Tom Hass for their help with this committee.

D. Endowment Fund: Pastor Karl Nelson reported that two gifts have been given so far this year. See attached report.

Old Business: There was no old business.

New Business:

A. Renewal of Operating Line of Credit: Debbie Meyer, church Treasurer, reported on the need for and the use of the line of credit. Andrea Meyer moved and Pastor Karl Nelson seconded that the line of credit be renewed. Adopted.

Adjournment: Norm Fenner moved and Judy Schroeder seconded that the meeting be adjourned. Adopted. The meeting was adjourned at 11:07 a.m.

Closing Prayer: Pastor Dave led us in the Lord's Prayer.

In addition to these events, we have approved events that **we are looking for volunteers** to lead a fall school supply drive for Helping Kids, a Chili Luncheon/Dinner in September for *God's Work. Our Hands.*, a Christmas capital fund collection, and a Brat Fry/Bake Sale on October 21st in partnership with the Trunk or Treat event.

Our social media and marketing continue to reach many each week. Thank you to Becky Kuhlow for maintaining our front sign messaging throughout the year!
