


Introduction to the Sacraments

- There are two Sacraments in the Lutheran Faith:
- Baptism
- The Lord's Supper
- ♦ A Sacrament is a visible sign of God's love that strengthens our faith. In the Sacraments God doesn't just tells us He loves us, He shows us!



- Which speak louder Words or Actions?
 - Someone says they like you, but then they physically hurt you.
 - A father testifies in court that he loved his child, but there is evidence of neglect and abuse.
 - A teacher says she loves teaching, but seems bored, and gets angry when a student asks for help.
 - A Church Youth Leader preaches at the Youth Gathering that people should live a holy life, but on Monday is seen at a party with booze, drugs and sex.
 - A salesman promises you that you can return the video game for any reason, but a friend who bought the game earlier and tried to return it was told that the store never took merchandise back, nor gave refunds.
- Emotion Pantomime: Without saying a word act out these emotions.



- ♦ In the Sacraments God shows us that He does not just love the whole faceless world in general, but that He loves each one of us as individuals, by name.
 - How would you feel if you asked your mother, "Do you love me?" and she said, "I love the whole world."?
 - How would you feel if you asked your boyfriend if he thought you were special, and he replied, "I think all the girls in Junior High are special."?
 - How would you feel if you asked your coach if she thought you were a great athlete, and she responded, "I think everyone on the team is a gifted athlete"?
 - How would you feel if you received a letter that began, "To whom it may concern, I love you and think you are special."
- A sacrament must have three things:
 - 1. A visible sign
 - 2. Commanded by Jesus
 - 3. A promise of forgiveness
