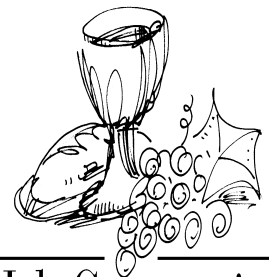


Introduction to the Sacraments

♦ There are two Sacraments in the Lutheran Faith:

- Baptism
- The Lord's Supper

♦ A Sacrament is a visible sign of God's love that strengthens our faith. In the Sacraments God doesn't just tell us He loves us, He shows us!

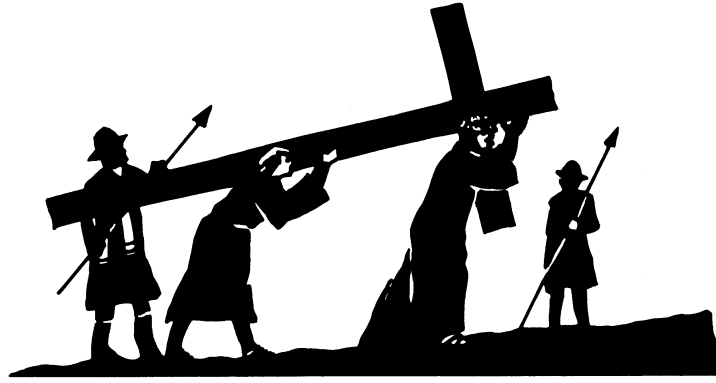


Holy Communion

 - How would you feel if you asked your coach if she thought you were a great athlete, and she responded, “I think everyone on the team is a gifted athlete”?
 - How would you feel if you received a letter that began, “To whom it may concern, I love you and think you are special.”
