It has been a privilege to serve as the Interim Pastor at St. Luke since July of 2022. St. Luke is blessed to have Pastor Karl Nelson serve as Sunday worship leader when I am away. A special word of thanks to our organists Karen Bruinooge and Kathy Nelson; our Office Administrator Andrea Meyer; the church custodian Kristin Madson; the dedicated Church Council members, and the many volunteers who joyfully give their time and talents as partners in the Gospel.

Thanks to Becky Kuhlow's leadership, the Sunday School Staff, and the partnership of parents, Confirmation Instruction, Sunday School, and Vacation Bible School were offered this past year. Miranda Sucha and Carter Perman completed their catechetical instruction and affirmed their baptisms in May. The Quilters keep making beautiful quilts which are sent to the poor and needy throughout the world. I officiated at three funerals this year, and I am impressed how Jeff and Donna Parrish help families with gravesite arrangements, and how the congregation supports the grieving families. Throughout my months with you, I have provided hospital and home/facility visits, pastoral emails, and phone calls to members. I officiated at one wedding during the summer, as did Pastor Karl, and I baptized my Great Niece, Lainey Flo.

During 2023, St. Luke was blessed to receive six adults and five children as new members.

Bishop Paul and Pastor Kristin from the Greater Milwaukee Synod have been working with the congregation, most recently through the Church Council, in making arrangements for a contract Pastor to begin serving here. (As I write this report finalization of the details for the contract position are still in process.) I am grateful to the Mission Exploration Team and members of the Call Committee whose faithful work early in the Interim laid the foundation for the Contract Position.

In closing, St. Luke is growing in unity, grace, wisdom and faith. Unchurched people are looking for a church that will help them and their children come to know God. The fields are ripe for the harvest! I am grateful to our gracious Lord for the opportunity to have served with you in the ministries of outreach, worship, service, pastoral support, fellowship, visitation, and education which St, Luke continues to offer. I will always hold you with fondness in my heart.

**B. Treasurer:** Debbie Meyer reported on the General Fund, Capital Fund, Endowment Fund, and the Summary of actual costs vs. the budgeted costs of our church. The last day of Sunday Church School will be May 19. Sunday School will sponsor a coffee hour with Bingo following on May 19. Weekly attendance at Sunday School has been 5. Becky is looking for volunteers to head up Vacation Bible School this summer.
- 4. **Maintenance:** Aaron Strassburger reported that the parsonage landscaping is complete. He continues to work on the parsonage flooring.
- 5. **NOW:** Laura Meyer reported that the NOW (Nurture, Outreach, Witness) 2024 plan is now available. In our annual meeting packet is a page devoted to NOW ideas for the 2024 year. All items marked with a heart can be chosen by volunteers as projects. Volunteers can include children and grandchildren. See attached report.
- 6. **Arts and Environment:** Lavonne Schroeder thanked Paul Schroeder, Laura Meyer, Randy Meyer and everyone who helped with Christmas decorations. She is working on a puzzle station in the library and would welcome a donation of a puzzle cabinet. Lavonne thanked the church council for working well together and for everyone who helps beautify our church.

**D. Endowment Fund:** Pastor Karl reported that all distribution money is now in one money market fund. Each year 80% of the growth of the Endowment Fund is deposited in the money market fund for possible distribution. See attached report.
