**SUNDAY SCHOOL TEACHER SIGN-UP:** We'd like to start getting people lined up to teach Sunday School for the 2025-26 school year. Sunday School starts at 8:30 and runs until shortly before worship starts at 9:30am. We offer lots of support and all the materials needed. Currently we are running a "one-room-schoolhouse" for kids ages 4 - 6th grade. That might change based on how many kids we have and how the ages break out.

Few things are more joyful and important than helping little ones experience the faith community. That's what we do each week. You need virtually no bible

knowledge...what you do need is in the materials. What you most bring is love and a little structure and then based on how you are, some mix of games, art, music, serving projects, mini-construction projects, outdoor scavenger hunts, science "experiments," you name it! We welcome our kids, engage them, and teach them how faith is about everything in life! We need four teachers signed up so that you can rotate weeks (meaning, typically teaching only once a month), have two people there on big weeks (think Christmas program), and bring different styles and gifts to our kids. Teachers have traditionally been moms, which is great. We'd like to expand that a little by having at least one man, one person over age 65 and then anyone confirmed age (say 15) and up, who wants to give it a try. Talk to John H-I if you have questions. MOUNT MERU COFFEE- Mt. Meru is in Tanzania. As part of our partnership with Lutherans in Tanzania, we help support their communities that grow, harvest and sell coffee. ## "Summer"



For I love in your warmth and your fragrance to stay.


