They have made for themselves a golden calf and have worshiped it and sacrificed to it and said, 'These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt!" 9 And the Lord said to Moses, "I have seen this people, and behold, it is a stiff-necked people. <sup>10</sup> Now therefore let me alone, that my wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them, in order that I may make a great nation of you." 11 But Moses implored the LORD his God and said. "O Lord, why does your wrath burn hot against your people, whom you have brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? 12 Why should the Egyptians say, 'With evil intent did he bring them out, to kill them in the mountains and to consume them from the face of the earth'? Scrip

On line Scrip has made a change. It is now Raise Right and is the same as the phone app. If you wish to shop on line for Scrip cards use RaiseRight.com to sign in. You can find all the merchants offering Scrip cards and the percentage of rebate to St. Mark's. Special offers are also available on line with increased percent.

Sign up for the Raise Right app on your phone. It is a simple process to create an account. If using your personal banking information, Raise Right will put a small deposit into your account to verify. You need to sign in to your Raise Right account and acknowledge the amount to complete the setup. Now you are ready to purchase cards on the go. Most merchants offer ecards that can be purchased right in the store. It's an easy way to help support your church.

To add a little incentive for the Raise Right app, whoever purchases the highest value of cards through the app now until July 1 will win a \$25 card from our inventory.

## **Online Giving**

St. Mark's introduces a new electronic option for making your offerings to the church.

We are utilizing VANCO Financial Solutions to safely and securely make your offering. Your gift will be automatically debited from your checking/savings account or processed using your debit/credit card.

Vanco Online Giving allows:

- 1. Anytime and anywhere giving, conveniently and securely.
- 2. No need to write out physical checks or prepare envelopes.
- 3. Schedule for and manage recurring offerings.
- 4. View your complete online-giving history.

You can set up a user name and password if you choose. Donations can be made without setting up an account.

There is also the option for giving through the VANCO app. It is available on Google Playstore or the Apple Store. Look for St Marks Evangelical Lutheran Church in the app. It should show our address and phone number. Offerings can be made through your bank account or by credit card.

In either method, donations can be one time or a regular schedule can be set up. If through your bank account the fee is only 1% Credit card donation fees are 2.85% of the total gift. You can choose to cover that fee in your gift.
