

Any surplus funds at the end of our fiscal year (June 30) will be discussed with the congregation at the annual budget meeting. The remaining mortgage is \$97,311 as of 2-28-23.




ATTENTION

Please turn these in as soon as you are able. THANKS!








Sound Board Operators Training

Thank you to everyone at St. Matthews who purchased Butter Braids for the preschool's winter fundraiser. There were 219 items sold, which should result in a net profit of \$1,314. Last year, this fundraiser netted the preschool about \$1,000 so it's fabulous to do even better this year. Fundraiser monies are used to

offset the reduced income due to this year's low enrollment numbers.

An open house is planned for **Tuesday, April 11**; this is an excellent time for prospective students/ parents to meet the teachers and explore the classroom.
