AN INTRODUCTION AND A LITTLE HISTORY

Dave Anderson grew up as a Lutheran pastor’s son in MN, SD, and WI. He attended Augustana Academy in Canton, SD; Augsburg College and the U of MN in Minneapolis. In 1963, Dave began a ministry which became known as Lutheran Youth Encounter, now known as Youth Encounter – today the largest Lutheran youth ministry in the world. In 1968, Dave became youth director at Central Lutheran, Van Nuys, CA; and, in 1969, began Lutheran Youth Alive which many described as “the Lutheran version of the Jesus Movement.”

In September, 1974, Dave left youth ministry and began to sing full-time. In November of that year, Dave and Barb were reunited after having lost track of each other for over nine years. They were married and from June, 1975, to November, 2010, they presented 5,250 concerts all over the world. Dave estimates that they flew 1 million miles and drove 2 million miles during those 35 ½ years.

Dave and Roger's music is a blend of contemporary, gospel, hymns, and lots of old-time Sunday school songs. The audience will be invited to sing along but, as Dave says, "so long as it's the same song." Dave Anderson comes from Phoenix, Arizona; and Roger and his wife, Patti, live in Corona, California.

Roger Walck is a skilled vocalist, guitarist, and a worship team leader. Roger is a graduate of Vanguard University and he has studied at Fuller Seminary and Azusa Pacific University. For many years, Roger taught theology at Orange Lutheran High School in Orange, California. For many years Roger has led Spanish-language worship in various Orange County churches.

Fellowship Ministries was the catalyst to help start the contemporary worship movement within the Lutheran denomination, publishing *The Other Songbook*, *The Best of the Best in Contemporary Praise & Worship*, and sponsoring over 250 worship and music conferences and seminars all over America and Australia.

In 1993, Dave, Barb, and five others survived a plane crash in the Bering Sea while returning from a mission in the Russian Far East. This incredible story has been told in a book and a documentary DVD called *The Rescue*, and the story has been heard and seen on radio and TV programs around the world.

Besides his music, the main focus of Dave’s ministry is the Shepherd’s Canyon Retreat ministry including the Development of **Standing Stones**, SCR’s new retreat center.

For over 30 years, we have had a dream of initiating a ministry to which church workers could come to receive help with their personal circumstances, strengthen their souls, and return to the calling with new tools for both healthy living and productive ministry.

After much prayer and planning by lay leaders, counseling professionals, and clergy, the first Shepherd's Canyon Retreat was held in March, 2009.

Each 7-day retreat includes up to four client couples (singles are welcome), two counselors – male and female – and a retreat chaplain. Our twelve retreat therapists have a combined 250 years of counseling experience! All counseling is Bible-based. \$3,500 covers the actual cost for each client couple for excellent accommodations, meals, and counseling fees. We ask clients to cover as much of this cost as they can and then Shepherd's Canyon Retreat covers whatever cost remains. These scholarship funds are made possible through the donations of friends who are standing with us to make this ministry-of-restoration possible.

Retreats begin with dinner on a Tuesday evening and end with breakfast on Tuesday morning one week later. The week's schedule includes 25 hours of group, couple, and individual counseling sessions.

The SCR ministry has purchased an 8.8 acre property in Arizona's high desert, 15 miles west of Wickenburg, AZ; 90 minutes from the Phoenix Sky Harbor Airport. This property includes a duplex, another small house, a large pool, and several acres on which we have built a place of healing and hope for hurting church workers. Our 3500 sq ft Fellowship House (8 bedrooms + group and private meeting space) is now ready for occupancy.
