



## Kairos Prison Ministry in McCormick

The next Kairos Prison Ministry walk at **McCormick County Correctional Institute (MCCI)** is March 21-24, 2023.

**Kairos Cookies:** Kairos Prison Ministry is known by some as “the cookie ministry.” Cookies represent God’s unconditional love, freely given to all.

This year, McCormick will only allow store bought, packaged cookies.

MCCI houses 600 men and 30 will be invited to join the walk in March. In order to provide cookies for attendees and all the residents in the facility, we will need 2,000 dozen (24,000) cookies. **The types of cookies that work best are Chocolate Chip, Fig Newton, Oatmeal (raisin), Sugar, Molasses, Oreo, and other sandwich type cookies.** Kairos cannot accept cookies that contain nuts, and the cookies must be in their original unopened packaging.

Please consider purchasing and donating cookies to support the ministry. Cookies need to be pre-packaged and delivered to **St. Paul by Sunday, March 11, 2023.** *Dollar Tree offers cookies at \$1.25 per package, minimum order of one case, 12 packages, for \$15. You can leave the case unopened; it makes it easier to load our truck for delivery.*

**Prayer wheel:** In our community room at McCormick, we display a whiteboard Prayer Wheel for each day of the walk, showing the hours of the day and names of people who are praying for the participants at that time). To sign up, click on this link [Prayer Vigils - McCormick March 21 - 24 2023](#). Scroll down to select the time you want to pray. You can also sign up on the paper sign-up sheet outside of the fellowship hall.

The Prayer Wheels are a visible sign to the residents that *Christians they don't even know are supporting them*. The sign-up form or website shows periods of 30 minutes or an hour, but we ask only that you take time within that period so that prayer continues non-stop. Of course, you are welcome to devote an hour of prayer. Don't stop with yourself; ask friends, family, and neighbors, anyone you know to join us on the Prayer Wheels.
