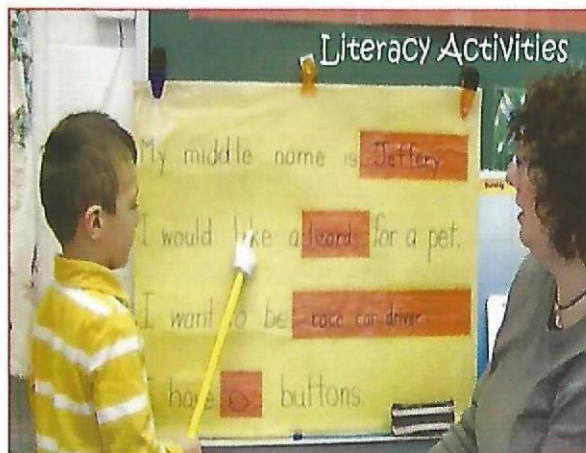
Our preschool offers multi-age classes.

3-day M/W/F 8:30-11:00 An expansion of the two-day program, providing more "hands-on time" with slightly more advanced work projects.

5-day M-F 8:30-11:00 Designed for the student who is on the verge of entering kindergarten with exposure to a full school week.

Enrichment Class M/W/F 11:00-2:45

This class enhances pre-kindergarten skills with emphasis on literacy, math and technology in preparation for Ohio's Common Core which will be implemented in grades kindergarten - 12th grade. It also builds a stronger literacy foundation in preparation for the required passing of Ohio's 3rd Grade Reading Guarantee.

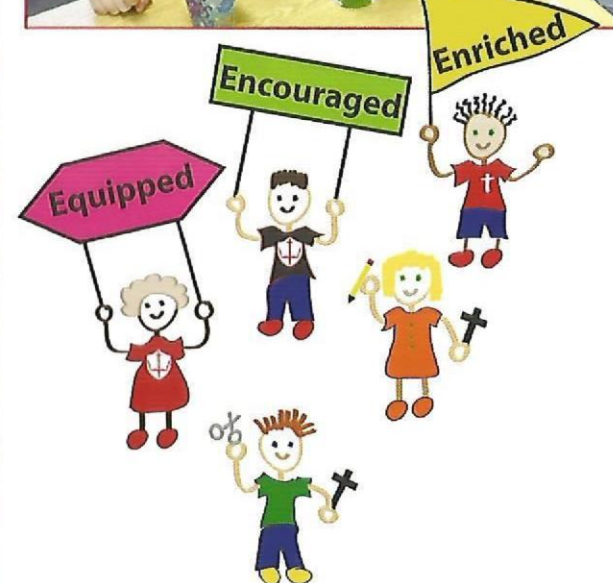
