Connecting the Dots . . . (after sermon discussion)

1. When you realize something is broken, what is your first response? Do you want to fix it, replace it, throw it away, or ignore it completely?
2. What does it look like for a person to live with a brokenness before God? How do we determine if we are truly broken? What is the difference between brokenness and sadness?
3. How would you describe the relationship between confession, contrition, humility, and repentance?

Digging Deeper Together (for further study during the week)

1. . As you look at the news of Nehemiah's day and his response, how can we justify going on apathetically with our normal lives right now in light of our daily news? (Nehemiah 1:3-4, 1 Timothy 2:1, Matthew 18:19-20, Ephesians 6:18)
2. If the walls and gates of Israel/Jerusalem were down with God's permission and judgement in response to His people's sin and rebellion, how is what is happening in the U.S. and the world at large any different? (Nehemiah 1:7-8, Ecclesiastes 12:14, Ezekiel 18:20-28, Revelation 22:12)
3. Nehemiah was a God-fearing man in his day. How does his prayer of confession of personal, family, and national sin show us how to respond to God's judgment upon our nation today? (James 5:16, 2 Chronicles 7:13-15, Daniel 9:2-6, Psalm 51:17)
