Nehemiah 8, 9, and 13

Connecting the Dots . . . (after sermon discussion)

2. How are God's laws good for us? How are they like guardrails? (Deuteronomy 10:12-15, Psalm 19:7-8, Romans 7:12-13)
3. How does obedience help our relationship with God? How does God respond to our disobedience? (Nehemiah 9:16-20, Romans 5:8)
