### **Connecting the Dots . . .** (after sermon discussion)

1. How are you following God's plan for your life, or have you been calling an audible (deciding on a different plan instead of God's plan for you)?
2. How do people most easily describe you? Do they point to your job, your family name, your address, or something else?
3. How does your faith in Jesus Christ bring your life into clear focus even when many other parts of life are blurry?

### **Digging Deeper Together** (for further study during the week)

1. What does it mean to "walk in a manner worthy of the calling," and how does it change things that Paul is "urging" us to do this as he sits in a prison cell because of his faith in Jesus? (vs. 1-7, Matthew 16:24-26)
2. How do you know when your Christian life working properly? And when it is, how are you helping the rest of the body of Christ grow? (vs. 11-16)
3. How does your life line up your faith? How does your personal daily lifestyle affect the rest of the body of Christ? (vs. 25-32, Isaiah 64:4-8)
