## Ephesians 5

### Connecting the Dots . . . (after sermon discussion)

1. Have you ever been a part of a toxic work environment? What about a really good and loving work environment?
2. Have you ever been through on-the-job training? Were you just handed a book or told to figure it out, or were you guided by someone and asked to imitate them? Which works better and why?
3. Are there things in your life that still need exposed by the light of Jesus? As you go through the list in verses 3-6, what has Jesus already brought you out of in your life?

### Digging Deeper Together (for further study during the week)

1. How can we know how to be imitators of God? How did Jesus give himself up for us, and what did it accomplish? (1 Thessalonians 1:6; Hebrews 1:2-3; Ephesians 5:2, 25-27)
2. Why should we submit to other Christians? How do we do that? give up selfishness, works of darkness, disobedience, living your own way. (Philippians 2:3, 1 John 3:16)
3. How does marriage of one man and one woman for life point to Christ's relationship with the church? How does Jesus want his church to be presented? (1 Corinthians 7:39, 2 Corinthians 6:14, Ephesians 5:27)
