

TODAY'S LIGHT BIBLE STUDY

WEEK 59

JEREMIAH 15:1—28:17

In this week we have looked at the day of disaster, keeping the Sabbath holy, Jeremiah at the potter's house, Jeremiah and Pashhur, Jeremiah's complaint, God rejecting Zedekiah's request, judgment against the evil kings, the Righteous Branch, the lying prophets, the false oracles and false prophets, the two baskets of figs, the seventy years of captivity, the cup of God's wrath, Jeremiah being threatened with death, Judah to serve Nebuchadnezzar, and the false prophet Hananiah.

Jeremiah 15:7 tells us: "I will winnow them with a winnowing fork." What is a winnowing fork, and how did people use it?

What is God commanding Jeremiah in chapter 16:2?

How is Jeremiah to answer people who want to know why God is punishing them (Jeremiah 16:10-13)?

Jeremiah 17:1 tells us: "Judah's sin is engraved with an iron tool." What does this mean?

What will happen if the people do not keep the Sabbath (Jeremiah 17:19-27)?

What illustration does God give to Jeremiah at the potter's house (Jeremiah 18:3-10)?

In Jeremiah 19:2 God tell Jeremiah to go to the Potsherd Gate. What is the Potsherd Gate?

What is going to happen to Pashhur, the chief officer of the Temple (Jeremiah 20:6)?

What is Jeremiah complaining about in Jeremiah 20:7-10?

What does the Lord say to Zedekiah, through the prophet Jeremiah, concerning those who stay in the city and those who surrender to Babylon (Jeremiah 21:8-10)?

Jeremiah 22:5 tells us: “I [the Lord] swear by myself.” Why does God swear by Himself?

What is Jeremiah 23:5 a prophesy about?

Jeremiah 23:34-40 tells us about the false oracles and the false prophets. What are false oracles and false prophets?

What do the two baskets of figs represent in Jeremiah 24:1-10?

Jeremiah 25:9 mentions Nebuchadnezzar. Who is Nebuchadnezzar?

Jeremiah 26:6 mentions Shiloh. To what does Shiloh refer?

What does Jeremiah tell Hananiah after Hananiah breaks Jeremiah’s wooden yoke (Jeremiah 28:15-17)?
