HABAKKUK 1:1—ZECHARIAH 2:13

In this week we have looked at Habakkuk's complaint, the Lord's answer, Habakkuk's second complaint, the Lord's answer, Habakkuk's prayer, warning of coming destruction against Judah, the great Day of the Lord, The Lord against Philistia, Moab, Ammon, Cush, Assyria, the future of Jerusalem, a call to build the House of the Lord, the promised Glory of the new House, blessings for a defiled people, Zerubbabel the Lord's signet ring, a call to return to the Lord, the man among the Myrtle trees, and a man with a measuring line.

What is God's answer as to what will happen to Judah and Jerusalem (Habakkuk 1:5-11)?

What is the Lord's response to Habakkuk's question: "Why are you silent while the wicked swallow up those more righteous than themselves" (Habakkuk 2:2-20)?

What do Teman and Mount Paran have to do with God's people (Habakkuk 3:3-5)?

What is meant by "For the director of music. On my stringed instruments." at the end of Habakkuk chapter 3?

What is so bad about stepping over a threshold (Zephaniah 1:8-9)?

What will not save the people on the Day of the Lord (Zephaniah 1:18)?

**What does God say that Moab and Ammon will be like (Zephaniah 2:9)?**
