### Psalm 4:1-8

**P** Answer me when I call, O God of my righteousness! You have given me relief when I was in distress. Be gracious to me and hear my prayer!

**C** O men, how long shall my honor be turned into shame? How long will you love vain words and seek after lies?

**P** But know that the LORD has set apart the godly for himself; the LORD hears when I call to him.

**C** Be angry, and do not sin; ponder in your own hearts on your beds, and be silent.

**P** Offer right sacrifices, and put your trust in the LORD.

**C** There are many who say, “Who will show us some good? Lift up the light of your face upon us, O LORD!”

**P** You have put more joy in my heart than they have when their grain and wine abound.

**C** In peace I will both lie down and sleep; for you alone, O LORD, make me dwell in safety.

### Jeremiah 33:14-16

<sup>14</sup>“Behold, the days are coming, declares the LORD, when I will fulfill the promise I made to the house of Israel and the house of Judah. <sup>15</sup>In those days and at that time I will cause a righteous Branch to spring up for David, and he shall execute justice and righteousness in the land.

<sup>16</sup>In those days Judah will be saved and Jerusalem will dwell securely. And this is the name by which it will be called: ‘The LORD is our righteousness.’”

### Luke 19:36–40

<sup>36</sup>And as he rode along, they spread their cloaks on the road. <sup>37</sup>As he was drawing near—already on the way down the Mount of Olives—the whole multitude of his disciples began to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice for all the mighty works that they had seen, <sup>38</sup>saying, “Blessed is the King who comes in the name of the Lord! Peace in heaven and glory in the highest!” <sup>39</sup>And some of the Pharisees in the crowd said to him, “Teacher, rebuke your disciples.” <sup>40</sup>He answered, “I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out.”
