MARK 9:1—15:47

In this week we have looked at the Transfiguration, the healing of a boy with an evil spirit, who is the greatest?, whoever is not against us is for us, causing to sin, divorce, the little children and Jesus, the rich young man, Jesus again predicts His death, the request of James and John, blind Bartimaeus receives his sight, the triumphal entry, Jesus clears the Temple, the withered fig tree, the authority of Jesus questioned, the parable of the tenants, paying taxes to Caesar, marriage at the resurrection, the greatest commandment, whose Son is the Christ?, the widow's offering, signs of the end of the age, the day and hour unknown, Jesus anointed at Bethany, the Lord's Supper, Jesus predicts Peter's denial, Gethsemane, Jesus arrested, before the Sanhedrin, Peter disowns Jesus, Jesus before Pilate, the soldiers mock Jesus, the crucifixion, the death of Jesus, and the burial of Jesus.

Mark 11:13 has Jesus cursing a fig tree. Why would Jesus curse a tree?

What answer did the chief priests and the teachers of the law give to Jesus' question in Mark 11:29?

Mark 12:13-17 deals with paying taxes. Why did people pay taxes in Jesus' day?

What does Jesus say is the greatest commandment (Mark 12:28-34)?

What does Jesus say concerning the duty of believers with the signs of the end of the age (Mark 13:9a)?

Who does Jesus say will betray him (Mark 14:20-21)?

How does Judas betray Jesus (Mark 14:45)?

Does Mark's Gospel identify who cut off the servant of the high priest's ear, and does it record that Jesus healed the man (Mark 14:45-52)?

Mark 14:53-65 has Jesus before the Sanhedrin. What was the Sanhedrin?

What blasphemy did Jesus speak to the Sanhedrin (Mark 14:62-64)?

What happened after Peter denied being with Jesus the third time (Mark 14:72)?

Why was Jesus brought before Pilate (Mark 15:1-15)?

What striking thing does Mark record at the death of Jesus (Mark 15:37-38)?

What was Pilate's reaction to the news of Jesus' death (Mark 15:43-44)?
