

TODAY'S LIGHT BIBLE STUDY

WEEK 80

LUKE 9:1—16:31

In this week we have looked at Jesus sending out the twelve, Jesus feeding the 5,000, Peter's confession of Christ, the Transfiguration, the healing of a boy with an evil spirit, who will be the greatest?, Samaritan opposition, the cost of following Jesus, Jesus sends out the seventy-two, the Parable of the Good Samaritan, at the home of Martha and Mary, Jesus' teaching on prayer, Jesus and Beelzebub, the sign of Jonah, the lamp of the body, six woes, warnings and encouragements, the Parable of the Rich Fool, do not worry, watchfulness, not peace but division, interpreting the times, repent or perish, a crippled woman healed on the Sabbath, the Parables of the Mustard Seed and the Yeast, the narrow door, Jesus' sorrow for Jerusalem, Jesus at a Pharisee's house, the Parable of the Great Banquet, the cost of being a disciple, the Parables of: the Lost Sheep, the Lost Coin, the Lost Son, the Shrewd Manager. Additional teachings, and the rich man and Lazarus.

What were the disciples to take with them, when Jesus sent out the twelve (Luke 9:3)?

What is the light that Jesus is talking about in Luke 11:33-36?

Luke 11:44 has Jesus saying: "Woe to you Pharisees, because you are like unmarked graves, which men walk over without knowing it." What was so bad about walking over unmarked graves?

What is the meaning of the Parable of the Rich Fool (Luke 12:16-21)?

What is Jesus telling us in Luke 12:22-34?

What is the division that Jesus says that he came to bring (Luke 12:49-53)?

What is the significance of the kingdom of God being compared to a mustard seed (Luke 13:18-19)?

What does Jesus mean when he said concerning Jerusalem: “I tell you, you will not see me again until you say, ‘Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord.’” (Luke 13:35)?

Luke 14:1-6 has Jesus eating at the house of a Pharisee. Who were the Pharisees?

What is the meaning of the Parables of the Lost Sheep and Lost Coin (Luke 15:1-10)?

Why was it offensive for the younger son to ask for his inheritance (Luke 15:11-32)?

What does Jesus tell us concerning serving two masters (Luke 16:13)?

What does the Rich Man want Lazarus to do for him in the end (Luke 16:27-28)?
