WEEK 84

ACTS 3:1—12:25

In this week we have looked at Peter healing the crippled beggar, Peter speaks to the onlookers, Peter and John before the Sanhedrin, the believers' prayer, the believers share their possessions, Ananias and Sapphira, the apostles heal many, the apostles persecuted, the choosing of the seven, Stephen seized, Stephen's speech to the Sanhedrin, the stoning of Stephen, the Church persecuted and scattered, Simon the sorcerer, Philip and the Ethiopian, Saul's conversion, Saul in Damascus and Jerusalem, Aeneas and Dorcas, Cornelius calls for Peter, Peter's vision, Peter at Cornelius's House, Peter explains his actions, the church in Antioch, Peter's miraculous escape from prison, and Herod's death

Acts 3:1-2 tells us that the beggar was placed in a place to beg to those who were going into the temple courts. What were the temple courts?

What does Peter say was the cause of the beggar being healed (Acts 3:16)?

Why were the Sadducees disturbed with the apostles (Acts 4:2)?

What did the Sanhedrin command the apostles not to do and did they obey them (Acts 4:18, 33)?

Why did Ananias and Sapphira both die (Acts 5:1-10)?

How did the apostles escape from jail (Acts 5:18-19)?

Why did the religious leaders have Peter and the other apostles flogged (Acts 5:40)?

Acts 6:1 tells us: "In those days when the numbers of disciples was increasing, the Grecian Jews among them complained against the Hebraic Jews." Why was there tension between the two groups?

What is a summary of what Stephen told the Sanhedrin (Acts 7:2-53)?

When Stephen is stoned, who is giving approval at his death (Acts 8:1), and what does he begin to do (Acts 8:3)?

What is the significance of the baptism of the Ethiopian eunuch (Acts 8:26-40)?

Where was Saul heading when Jesus came to him, and what happened to him (Acts 9:1-8)?

What did Saul do when he arrived at the synagogues in Damascus (Acts 9:20-22)?

Why did Peter call the animals in his vision unclean (Acts 10:9-14)?

What did Peter do for the household of Cornelius (Acts 10:46-48)?

What does Peter's explanation mean concerning Gentiles (Acts 11:1-18)?

What important first started at the church in Antioch (Acts 11:26)?

What did the disciples in the house first think when Peter came to the door after he was freed from prison (Acts 12:15)?

What did Herod have done to the guards when they could not find Peter (Acts 12:19)?

Why did the Lord judge Herod so severely (Acts 12:21-23)?
