have prepared, whose will they be?’ <sup>21</sup>So is the one who lays up treasure for himself and is not rich toward God.”

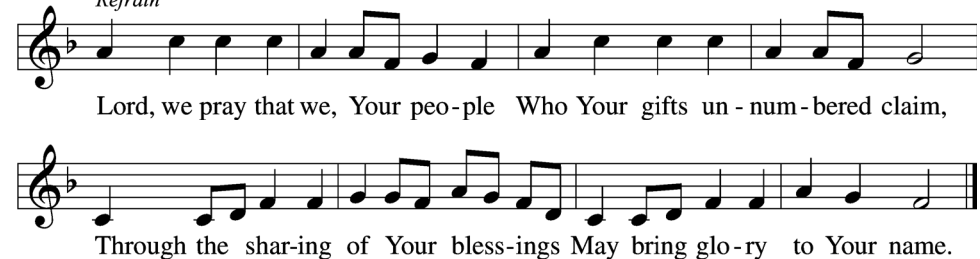

Text: Luke 12:13-21

## Nicene Creed



**C** Amen. Come, Lord Jesus.


