O Lord, my creator, redeemer, and comforter; as I come to worship You in spirit and in truth, I humbly pray that You would open my heart to the preaching of Your Word so that I may repent of my sins, believe in Jesus Christ as my only Savior, and grow in grace and holiness. Hear me for the sake of His name. Amen.

Luke 11:11 – “What father among you, if his son asks for a fish, will instead of a fish give him a serpent?” A generous, giving spirit comes from knowing that you have a generous, giving Father. He will care for our needs. We are therefore free to reflect His generosity in our lives. We can be generous in raising our children, supporting the church and serving our neighbor in the community. In these three areas — home, church and society — the Lord has called us to show His grace and generosity to those around us.

The Prayer of the Church Is the Voice of Faith

Jesus catechizes His disciples in the way of faith by teaching them how to pray. He promises us: “*Ask, and it will be given to you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it will be opened to you*” (Luke 11:9). If earthly fathers know how to give good gifts to their children, “*how much more will the heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him*” (Luke 11:13). Thus, father Abraham was bold in his prayer because he believed the gracious promise of the Lord, that he would “*surely become a great and mighty nation*” (Gen. 18:18). When we pray in Jesus’ name, we also hold “*fast to the Head*” (Col. 2:19), “*rooted and built up in him and established in the faith*” (Col. 2:6–7).

With this app you can watch services, email the church, receive church announcements, view the church calendar, give online, Youversion Bible app is included and view the church directory. We got this app for free from Universal Church Directory by doing the directory and earning credits.

To get the app on your phone or computer you will need a unique identifier from the office. This is a special code unique to your household that can be sent to you via email. This code is sent through the myUCD system so it will come from appsupport@ucdir.com not the office email. The app start guide is sent in the email and it gives you Android and I phone options in the email.

To get your code email the office at office@stpaulsosseo.org and Sherry will send your unique identifier to get you started. This app is very easy to use and will help keep all of us in touch with each other.
