O Lord, my creator, redeemer, and comforter; as I come to worship You in spirit and in truth, I humbly pray that You would open my heart to the preaching of Your Word so that I may repent of my sins, believe in Jesus Christ as my only Savior, and grow in grace and holiness. Hear me for the sake of His name. Amen.

Luke 12:15 – “**And he said to them, ‘Take care, and be on your guard against all covetousness, for one’s life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions.’**” Coveting is the opposite of being content with what God has given us. And the cure for coveting is twofold: thankfulness to God and generosity toward God’s purposes. So be on guard against all covetousness. Acknowledge that your Father has given you all that you need, and therefore be free and confident in directing the mammon of this world toward godly purposes.

Faith in Christ Is Rich Toward God

To live for earthly things “*is vanity and a striving after wind,*” and work that is driven by such vanity “*is an unhappy business*” (Eccl. 1:13–14). The man who lives like that has nothing to show for “*all the toil and striving of heart with which he toils beneath the sun ... all his days are full of sorrow*” (Eccl. 2:22–23). So, too, your “*covetousness, which is idolatry*” (Col. 3:5), makes a god out of that which cannot give you life or happiness. For “*one’s life does not consist in the abundance of his possessions*” (Luke 12:15). But “*Christ who is your life*” (Col. 3:4), in giving you Himself, gives you all the wealth of heaven. Instead of striving to lay up treasures for yourself, be “*rich toward God*” in Him (Luke 12:21).

We have a new app we are kicking off called myUCD (my universal church directory). If you do not want to add an app to your phone you can pull up the directory on your computer. With this app you can watch services, email the church, receive church announcements, view the church calendar, give online, Youversion Bible app is included and view the church directory. We got this app for free from Universal Church Directory by doing the directory and earning credits.

To get the app on your phone or computer you will need a unique identifier from the office. This is a special code unique to your household that can be sent to you via email. This code is sent through the myUCD system so it will come from appsupport@ucdir.com not the office email. The app start guide is sent in the email and it gives you Android and I phone options in the email.

To get your code email the office at office@stpaulsosseo.org and Sherry will send your unique identifier to get you started. This app is very easy to use and will help keep all of us in touch with each other.
