Hope & Harbor Rotating Homeless Shelter

St. Paul's will be hosting the Hope & Harbor Rotating Homeless Shelter again February 15 – 22. Volunteers are needed for Over-night (stay awake). Please contact the church office if you are able to help with this need!

Noisy Offering ~ We appreciate your nickels, dimes, and quarters!

For the month of February, the noisy offering will go to the High School Dental Program:

The Red Wing High School is in need of funds for the dental program that they are doing through the Free Clinic in Red Wing. First the students without insurance were checked by a dental hygienist from Children's Dental Health (organization out of Rochester) 150 students. Then they were referred for follow up with a dentist and that is where the Free Clinic stepped in to help out, otherwise these families would have had to take their children to Rochester for follow up. A grant for this program was received, however additional funding is needed to continue to serve these students.

Coat Shed Donations

Christ Episcopal Church has a Coat Shed on the East Ave. side of their facility, which is open 24/7 and is stocked with winter coats (children and adults), hats, mittens, scarves, boots, and blankets. The stock is very low. They welcome donations to their well-used coat shed from other congregations. Donations can be dropped off at the Christ Church office, M-F, 9am-3pm. or placed inside the shed at other times.



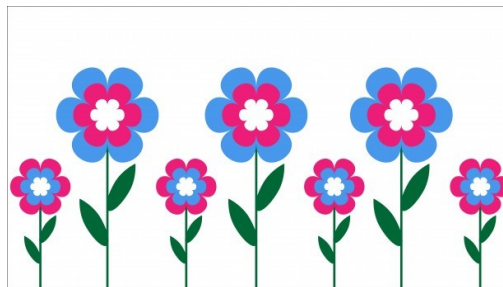

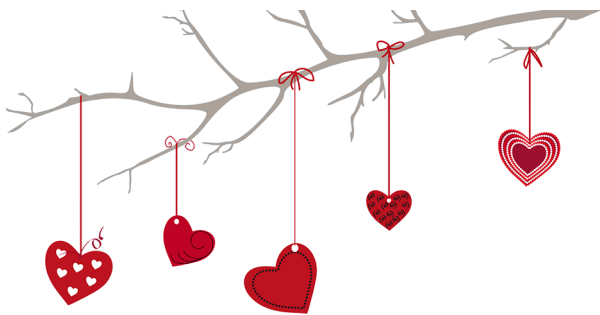
