## Exodus 3:1-15

- How old is Moses in chapter 3? Review his life.
- Jethro has two names. What is his other name? (2:16)
- Where is Mt. Horeb? Look at Pastor’s Map.
- Who appears to Moses? Look at vs. 2 & 4.
- What is unique about the bush?
- Why must Moses take off his shoes and stay at a distance? Why does he hide his face? Do we need to take off our shoes in church?
- How does God describe Himself in vs. 6?
- Has the Lord just now seen the afflictions of His people? Why did He wait so long? What caused Him to finally act?
- Vs. 8 – “I have come down” – act of saving! Theophany!
- What great promises does God make?
- God reveals his personal name: Yahweh



## Exodus 13:17-22

- Why did they not go through the land of the Philistines?
- How were Joseph’s body still able to be transported 400 years later?
- How did the people know that the LORD/Yahweh was with them? What would this visual manifestation do for the people of Israel? What do the means of grace do for us today?

**Exodus 14:15-20, 30-31**

- Notice again, how Yahweh and angel of the LORD are used interchangeably (vs. 19)
- Why does God move behind Israel? (vs. 19)

**Leviticus 9:1-2, 22-24**

- Who lights the altar?

**Acts 2:1-13**

- Which person of the Trinity manifests Himself?
- What miraculous event takes place to show God's presence?
- God comes down to SAVE!
