All Saints Banner

The banner hanging in the chancel today is our All Saints' Day Banner. The **lines flowing from the cross** represent the voice of our **Father**, the **cross** represents the **Son**, and the **dove** represents the **Holy Spirit**. The baptism shell and water remind us of our baptism, when God made us His saints. On the white material members have written more than 400 names of baptized believers whom God has called to their heavenly home to wait with His saints on earth for the final Day of Judgment, where all His saints will enjoy, body and soul, His new creation forever with the Lord.
