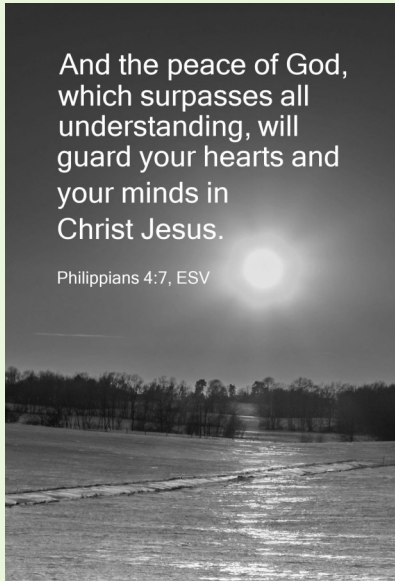

will even question God. So, instead of questioning God, ask God for clarity and then ask yourself, "Is what I'm doing ministering to people or does it have the potential to minister to people?" When you find the peace and joy of God in what you're doing, then you are fulfilling the purpose God has for you.

**Isaiah 55:12 (ESV)** says:

<sup>12</sup>"For you shall go out in joy and be led forth in peace; the mountains and the hills before you shall break forth into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap their hands.



God gives us peace and joy to let us know we're fulfilling His perfect plan. That doesn't mean it will be easy or that everything will go as planned.

Examine your life and pay close attention to those things you are drawn to that are ways in which you can minister as an everyday missionary to people alongside Jesus as He is messing with people.

Then let God be God in your life. He wants to flow through you and it may not be in the same way as He flows through others. Trust His ability in and through you and don't be afraid to be unique. God has a specific place and a specific plan for each of us and that includes you. How will you know you're in the right place fulfilling His plan? You will have peace!
