

## **Increasing in Love**

2 Thessalonians 1:3 (ESV) says, <sup>3</sup>We ought always to give thanks to God for you, brothers, as is right, because your faith is growing abundantly, and the love of every one of you for one another is increasing.

When Paul says, 'the love of every one of you for one another is increasing,' it's not the kind where life's perfect and everybody accommodates you. God's intention is to 'increase' your love into the kind of love that's not defined by your feelings, but a sacrificial love. God defines this sacrificial love in *Galatians 2:20 (ESV)* which says, <sup>20</sup>I have been crucified with Christ. It is no longer I who live, but Christ who lives in me. And the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave himself for me.

It's possible to be in love with the idea of a perfect marriage, without actually loving your mate; or the dream of what your kids could become, if only they'd follow your advice. But, when it comes to loving a rebellious teen, it's a growing process that puts your love to the test.

Jesus says in John 13:34 (ESV), <sup>34</sup>A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another: just as I have loved you, you also are to love one another. Jesus never asks us to do anything without giving us the ability to do it. Are you ready to do a little increasing?

Author Kristin Armstrong says: 'When we're hurt it's common to withdraw. But the worst thing a parent can do is to withhold affection in response to a child's behavior. A child's heart grows when it's nurtured with unconditional love. Affection doesn't depend on behavior, mood, or circumstances. Being pleasing does not equate to being lovable. Imagine if Jesus loved us only when we behaved perfectly. We'd never experience His
